**Eligibility Requirements**

- Eligibility requires current enrollment as a junior or higher in high school in Hawai‘i, or in an equivalent educational curriculum with the following requirements:
  - Must have attended at least 8 years of schooling in Hawai‘i
  - Must fulfill a minimum GPA requirement of 3.75
  - Must fulfill 300 hours of community service or volunteer hours in the Hawai‘i community (i.e. healthcare clinics, sporting events, small businesses, beach clean ups)
  - Must be currently participating as a team member on at least one sports team for the past 4 years (can be high school or club league)
  - Must have at least 2 letters of recommendation, 1 from an academic influence and 1 from a sports influence
  - Must complete the 3 Essay Questions
    - You CANNOT use Chat GPT or a form comparable to this software/program that assists in creating and enhancing the art of language.
  - Must be able to perform an in-person interview if requested
  - Must be able to accept the scholarship award in person and authorize being on all Aloha Legends Hawai‘i’s social media platforms.
  - Must be able to perform a 1,5 and 10-year follow up interview upon request and update personal growth information to the organization
  - Confirmation letter and/or commitment letter to either trade school or college within the United States for the upcoming semester.
